Present: Evelyn, Polly, Dick, Nancy, Dave, Faye, Steve, John, Terry, Terrell,

Treasurer's Report: \$1677.69 in Flash: Costs: Whitney \$74.00 to test for heartworm, Income \$255.00, SIGRC Income from charity mania \$1480. Club members sold 78 tickets, Costs, Charity mania set up \$468, other costs \$533.00 Balance in SIGRC \$2598.52 Insurance for the year has been paid \$257.00

Eye and Heart Clinic: Evelyn presented information regarding two doctors from the Purdue vet school. Dr. Khrone who does eyes will do eyes at a cost of \$21 per dog if she can do up to 140 dogs in one day. If it drops below 100 the cost goes to \$25.00. She would prefer to come for one day and either start around 10:00 am and go until 5-6 or come the night before and start at 8:00 This would mean we would have to do a Sunday only since the clinic is opened until noon on Saturday. Dr. Green, heart man, will charge \$25 per dog. E will find out if Dr. Green is ok with riding together etc. If they only come for one day we have no overnight fee and not much for food. If they ride together Dr. Khrone wants .50 per mile (it is about 88 miles less than the MO Drs trip. Round trip would be a savings of 176 miles.) If they ride separately she will take .38 cents per mile. E will try and negotiate this. Club authorized E to go ahead and see if they can work out a deal for the first or 2nd week end in Aug. or the last in July.
. Last year we did 133 dogs over two days and 63 hears over 2 days. We should be able to accommodate this amount on a single Sunday if we let people know ahead of time it is one day only. We hope to make a modest profit on the clinic so that we can fund more rescue dogs.

Rescue: Whitney was adopted out to Terrell Costello's sister, Julie Renie Annie the female at VHS was adopted by the Meyers family. Barb is grooming her for them. Paws has a boy they found running loose.
Tom Hayden is no longer at animal control. The new manager, Kerry will contact us if a Golden comes in. EW will get him a copy of the 501c3 letter since they seem to have lost the one we originally gave them.

Terry is still working on the AKC list. She needs Jamie and Tom and Laura's form to send them.

Christmas Party: Will be held at F's in Newburgh. It is on Sunday December 9 at 1:00. Nancy and Evelyn will help with games.

New Business: Evelyn passed out the home visit forms she had gotten from the Tennessee Golden Rescue Club.

It was noted we can save Purina Weight circles and turn them in for coupons. Evelyn noted she has 3 cases of dog food that were donated for future foster homes.
